21,000 community members and **6,000** local and regional officials trained in financial and community project management, participatory planning and assessment decentralization.

2.5 million people in over **2,000 villages**

have better schools, healthcare, access to water, and energy-saving street illumination.

Build capacities of local communities and authorities in applying community-based approach, participatory local planning and public service delivery, rehabilitating basic social and communal infrastructure, and developing small farm and non-farm businesses.

Integrate communitybased approaches to local governance and development in the curriculum of academia and educational nstitutions.




